

Jaya Jumrani joined the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) as a Scientist at the National Academy of Agricultural Research Management (NAARM), Hyderabad in September 2011. She completed her Master's Degree from the Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi in 2009. She was also awarded with scholarships at the Higher Secondary and Graduate level for her excellence in academics.
