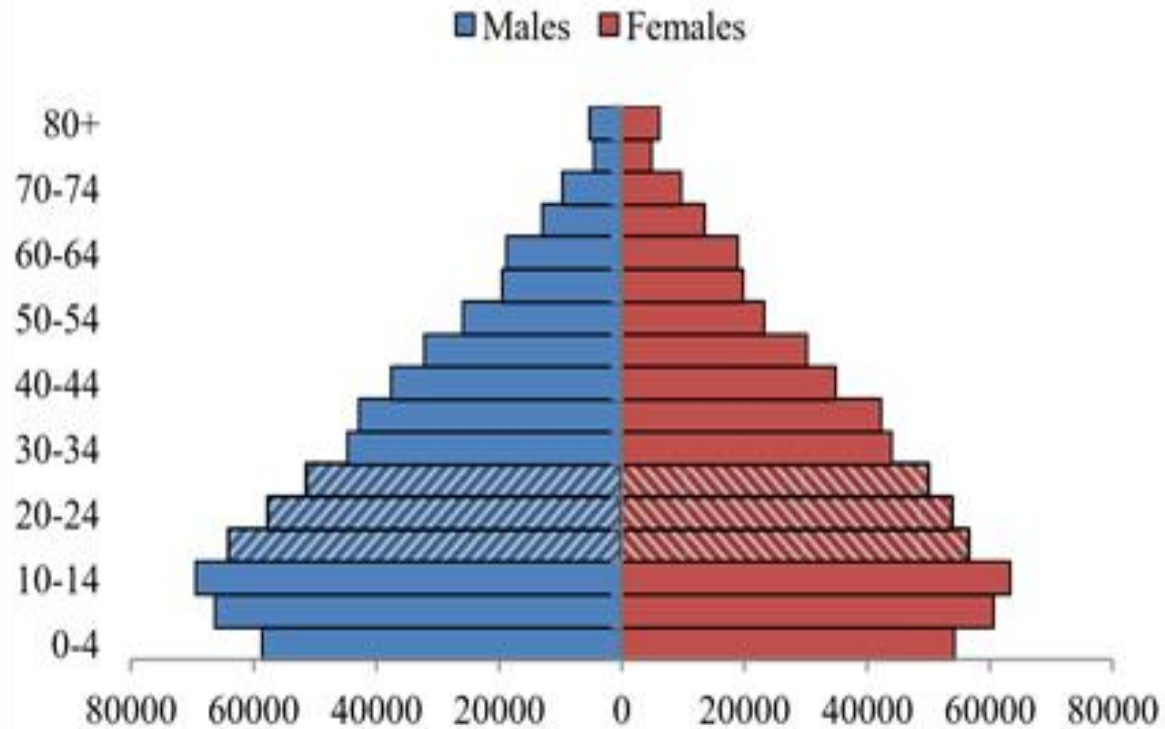

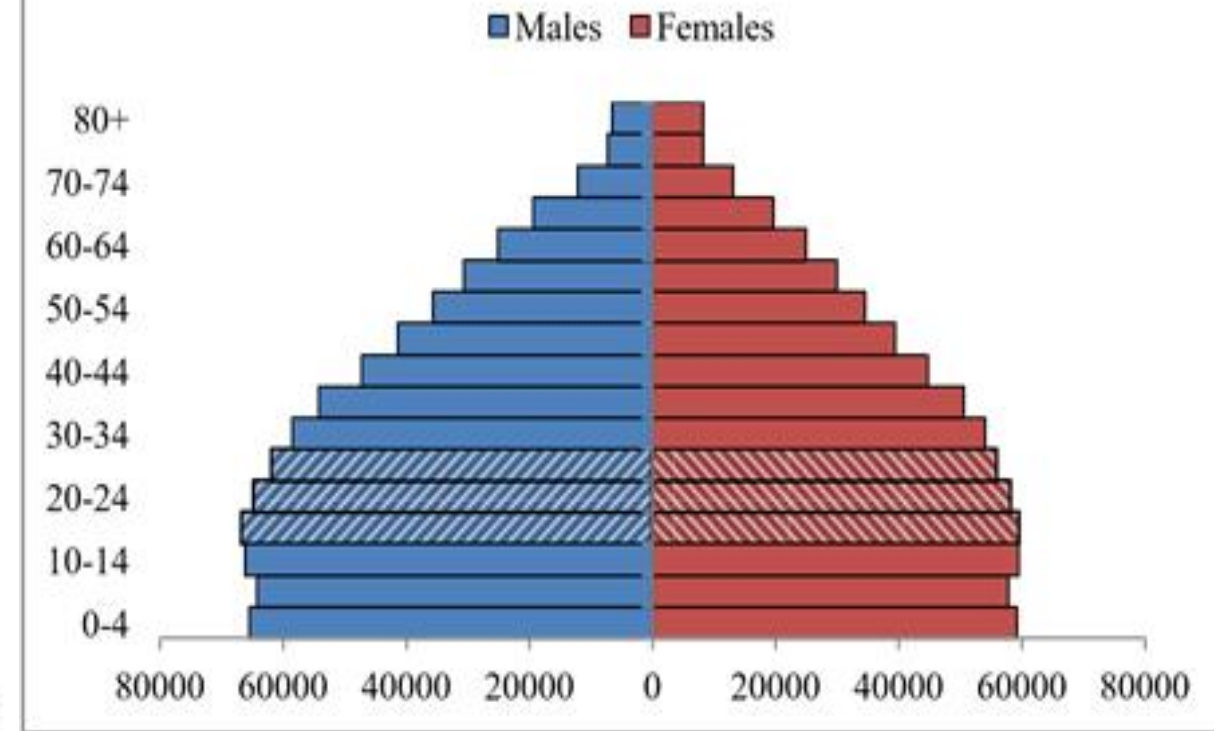


Demographic Dividend

Population Pyramid of India in 2021*

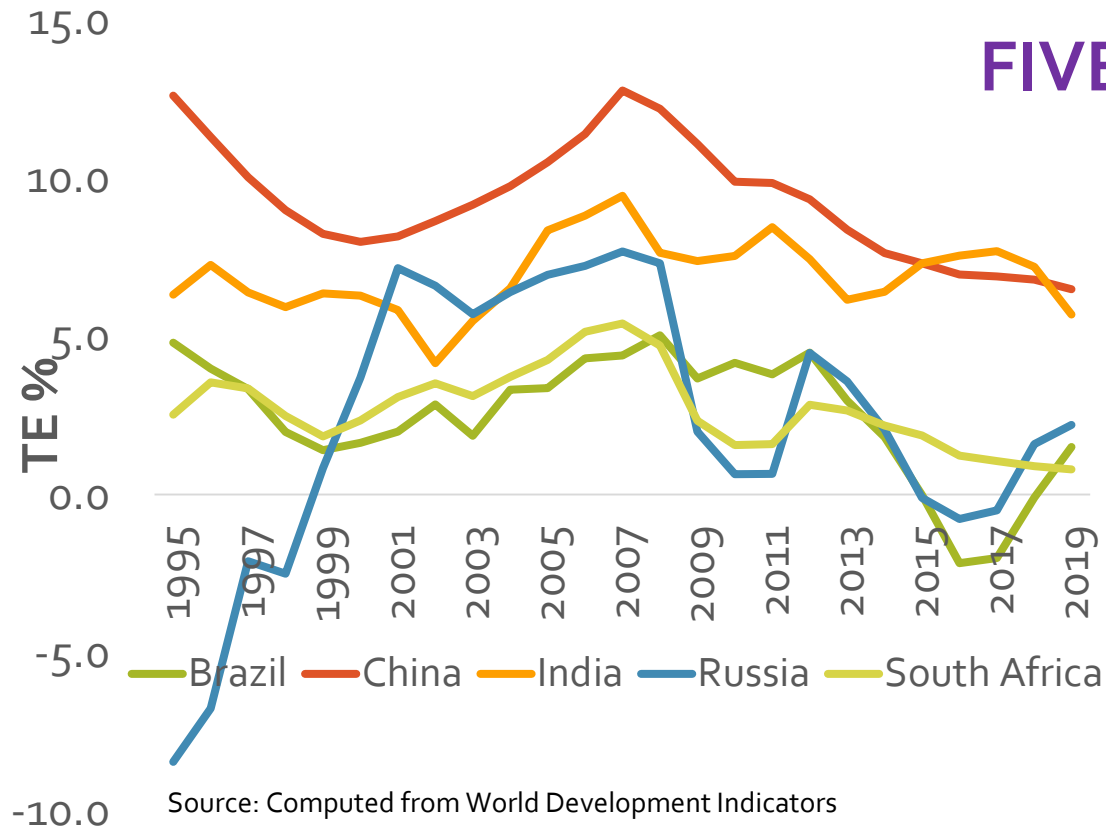

BRICS Countries GDP Growth (%)



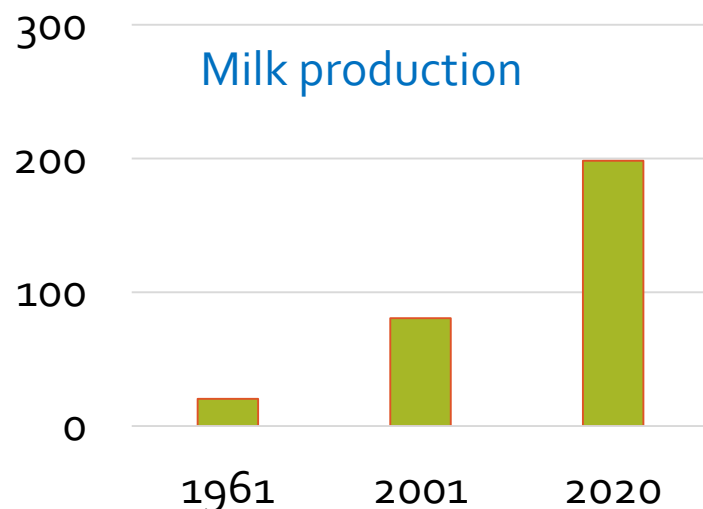
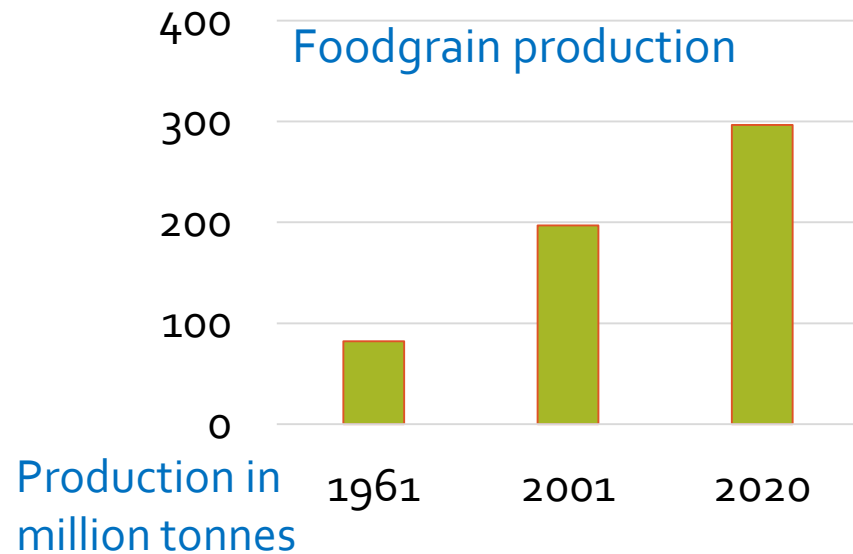

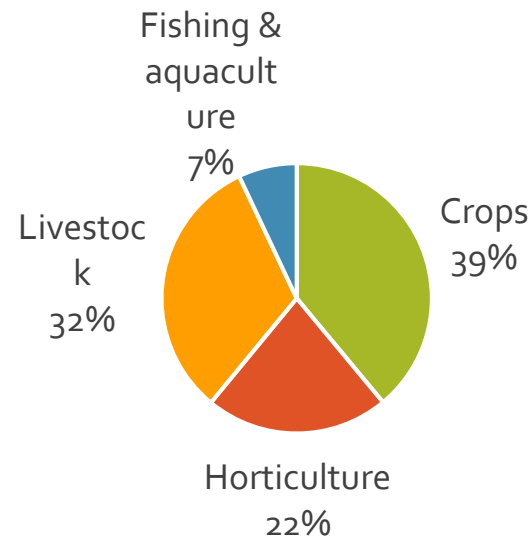

Indian Agriculture: shortage to surplus through application of science and policy



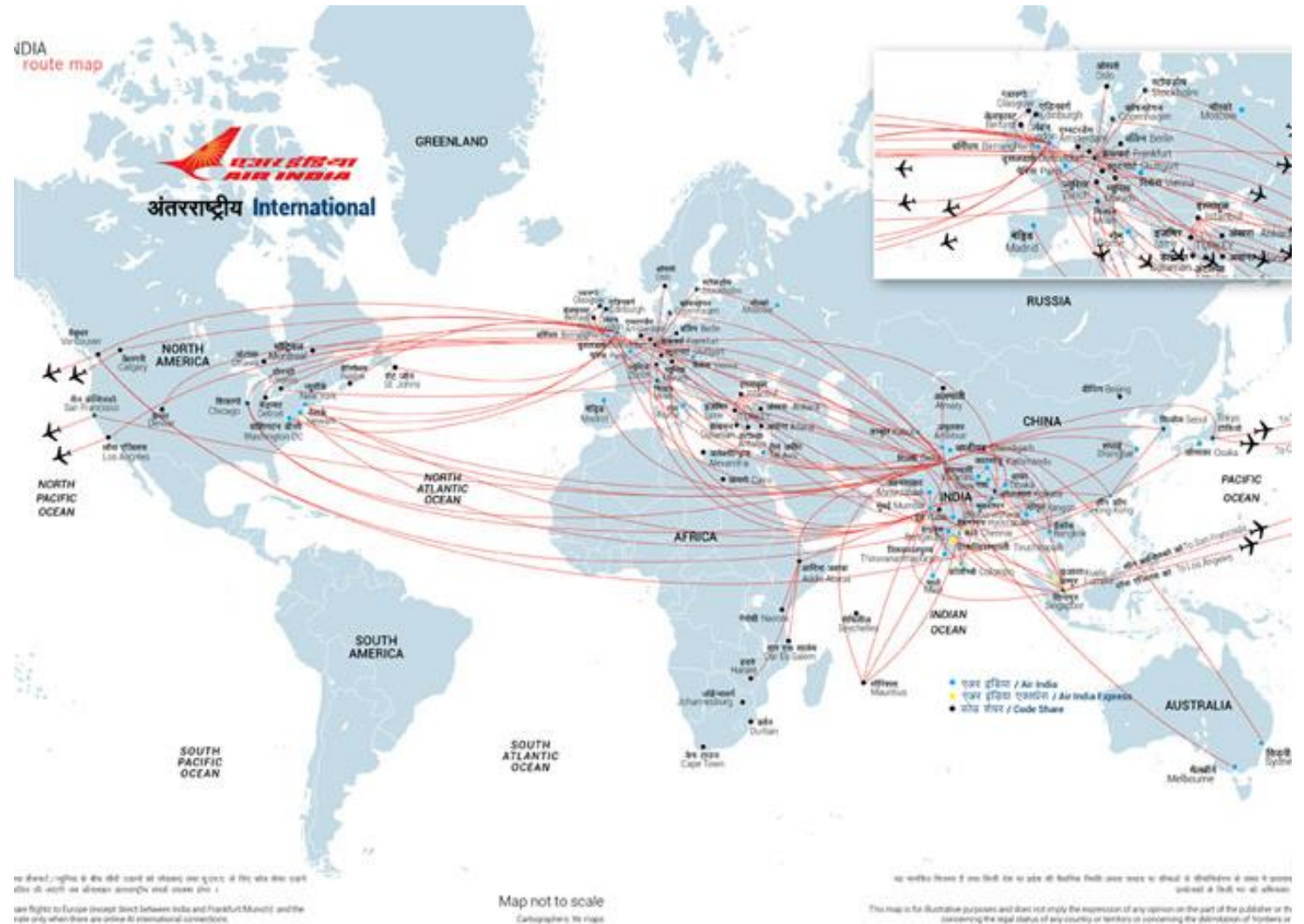

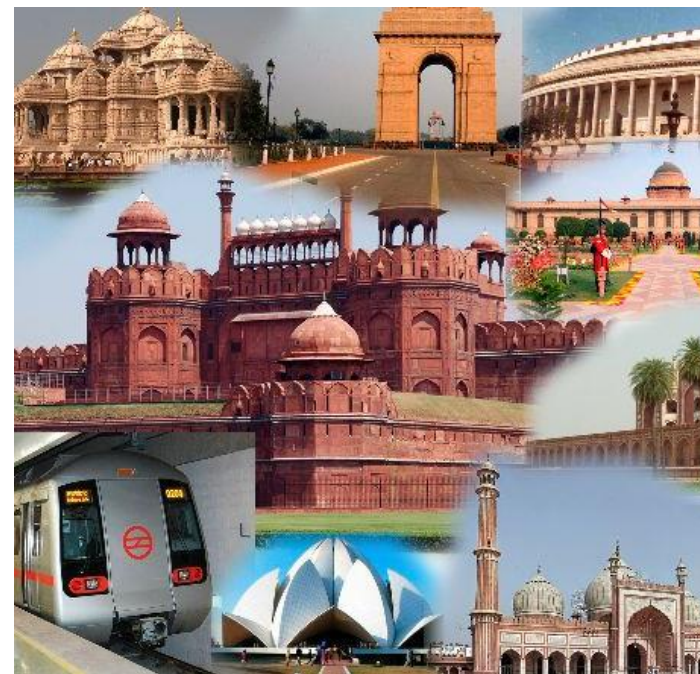
