








Indian Agriculture:

- Target to vaccinate entire adult population (940 million) by the end of 2021





CITY – NEW DELHI

- New Delhi is the capital city of INDIA
 - popular for its enriched culture with several world heritage sites
- Temperature in August- low of 26°C/ 79°F and high of 33°C/ 91°F.
- Likelihood of rainfall 50% (8 days in month)

Venue: National Agricultural Science Complex New Delhi





- Several guest houses and budget hotels are available near the conference venue








Mid-week conference tours- field tours (half to full day)






Rural Tourism : Ethnic Village and Eco Tourism Farm; Women's cooperative, sustainable farming methods rooted in Haryana


